

**VILLAGE OF BALDWIN
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
Monday, May 19, 2014 – 5:30pm**

The Village Board of the Village of Baldwin opened a special board meeting on Monday, May 19, 2014 at the Baldwin Municipal Center, 400 Cedar Street. President Zevenbergen called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

Roll call was taken by Clerk Tracy Carlson – Present: President Willy Zevenbergen, Trustees Lisa Knutson, Doug Newton, Duane Russett, Jennifer Recifo-Smith, Claire Stein, and Brian Nadeau.

Newton **moved** to convene to closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 19.85(1) (c) – Consideration of employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any village employee who is subject to the jurisdiction or authority of the commission. The Village Board will be determining a wage/benefit package for police chief position. Seconded by Russett. Motion carried. Closed session convened at 5:32pm.

President Zevenbergen reported to the board that the Police Commission had appointed Darren Krueger as Police Chief. The board discussed at length a wages/benefits package for him, comparing what he was currently making as an officer and what the previous chief was making when he retired. Russett moved to offer \$64,000-65,000 to Krueger. His benefit package will stay the same as he currently has. Seconded by Newton. Motion carried. Zevenbergen and Carlson will meet with Krueger to offer him the position with the salary range determined by the board.

Russett **moved** to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Zevenbergen. Meeting adjourned at 5:58pm.
