HISTORY OF CREAMERY PARK

- In 1892, a small creamery was located at the end of Front Street (now Main St.) serving the local residents.
- The Baldwin Creamery was founded in 1904, at which time the only thing accepted for processing was cream.
- During the early 1900's, butter could be made at a customer's request and it was processed by horse-driven power.
- Between 1925-1930, dry buttermilk was produced and sold to the public.
- Between 1947-1968, the Baldwin Creamery was known throughout Wisconsin for its award winning "Baldwin Butter".
- At its peak, The Baldwin Creamery would take in one million pounds of milk a day.
- Between 1969—2012, various owners ran different businesses from the buildings.
- In 2012, The Village of Baldwin obtained ownership of the property and removed the crumbling buildings.
- In 2014, the land was officially named CREAMERY PARK.
- 2012-future—The Village of Baldwin intends on creating a place where friends and family can gather which will include trails, flower beds and a park building.




